



Phishing Scams

Phishing Scams typically:

1. have statements in the email message that seem “too good to be true” or are “outlandish” in which they try to get you to react immediately;
2. ask for confidential information such as usernames, passwords, credit card numbers, social security numbers, account numbers, etc.; and
3. may not be personalized

Always report "phishing" or "spoofed" emails you receive that appear to be from Railroad & Industrial Federal Credit Union to reportphishing@rifcu.org. In the event that you receive email requesting updated debit and/or credit card information, please ignore the request. We will never email you for specific account information. If you receive email from us that you suspect is fraudulent, contact us at once (813) 621-6661 or (800) 769-1424 from 8:25 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. M-F; you may also forward all spam emails to reportphishing@rifcu.org.
